Note: Since Richard Johnson did not receive a majority of electoral votes (he got exactly half, 147 of 294), in accordance with the 12th Amendment to the Constitution, the U.S. Senate was required to choose the Vice President (for the first and only time). On Feb 8, 1837, the Senate elected Johnson (D) over Granger (W) by a vote of **33** to **16**.
