Notes: (1) One Nevada elector died before the electoral votes were cast. He was not replaced and, hence, only two of Nevada's three electoral votes were cast.

(2) Of the write-in votes, in Kansas, Ellsworth Cheeseborough received 543, some 78% of the entire total of write-ins nationwide. Cheeseborough had been a Republican candidate for elector in Kansas, but died before election day. Perhaps the write-ins were cast as an act of sympathy.

(3) States showing zero votes cast did not participate in the election due to the Civil War (and their secession from the Union).

(4) \*The Republican Party was also called the "National Union Party" in many states.
