Notes: *U (Under Electoral Votes), U stands for "uncast or uncounted electoral votes," as expounded upon in subsequent notes.

(1) Horace Greeley died on Nov 29, 1872. The 66 Electoral votes from the six states that would have been cast for him were divided as follows:

** Thomas Andrews Hendricks, 42 (Kentucky, 8 of 12; Maryland, 8; Tennessee, 12, Texas, 8; and Missouri, 6 of 15).

** Benjamin Gratz Brown (Greeley's running-mate), 18 votes (Georgia, 6 of 11; Missouri, 8 of 15; and Kentucky 4 of 12).

** Charles Jones Jenkins of Georgia received 2 votes from Georgia.

** David Davis of Illinois received 1 vote (1 of 15 from Missouri).

** Horace Greeley received three Elector's votes from Georgia, which, for unexplained reasons, were not counted by Congress.

(2) The 14 Electoral votes that Grant won in Arkansas (6) and Louisiana (8) were not counted by Congress because both parties claimed those states. See <http://www.ourcampaigns.com/RaceDetail.html?RaceID=1849> for details.

(3) Democratic Vice Presidential Electoral Votes were split amongst eight individuals, as detailed on the next page.

(4) In Iowa, a Liberal Republican slate of electors (for Greeley) captured 10,477 votes (4.83% of the total).
