* Democratic electoral votes were cast for two Vice Presidential candidates: Arthur Sewall (149) and Thomas Watson (27). Watson received 3 Georgia votes, 2 Louisiana votes, 4 Missouri votes, 1 Montana vote, 4 Nebraska votes, 5 North Carolina votes, 2 South Dakota votes, 1 Utah vote, 2 Washington votes, and 1 Wyoming vote. All other 149 Democratic electors voted for Arthur Sewall.

* In California and Kentucky, the direct election of nine and thirteen presidential electors combined with the closeness of the race in those states resulted in a split between the Democratic and Republican electors. In both states, the elector whom received the most votes was an elector for McKinley, and the vote totals for the leading elector for each candidate is reflected in this table. McKinley took 8 of 9 in California and 12 of 13 in Kentucky
