Note: Most of the "other" votes in Texas (135,444 of 137,306) were cast for the "Texas Regulars" ticket. The Texas Regulars were Anti-Roosevelt Democrat who hoped to deny Roosevelt a majority of the Electoral College and throw the election into the House of Representatives. This slate of delegates did not run under any candidate (and only in Texas) but, nonetheless, managed to out-poll (nationally) all candidates but Roosevelt and Dewey.
