Notes: 1. In Mississippi, the eight Unpledged Electors voted for Harry Byrd (President) and Strom Thurmond (Vice President). 2. In Oklahoma, one Nixon elector cast his vote for Harry Byrd (President) and Barry Goldwater (Vice President). 3. In Alabama, the 11 Presidential Electors were directly elected. Due to the result of a state primary, five of the Democratic electors on the general election ballot were "loyalists" pledged to Kennedy and the remaining six were "Free" electors, not pledged to the Democratic national ticket. These six "Unpledged" electors cast their ballots for Harry Byrd (President) and Strom Thurmond (Vice President). In this compilation, the popular votes for Democratic electors are divided with 5/11ths allocated to Kennedy and 6/11ths allocated to Unpledged to more accurately reflect the makeup of the electors. 4. The votes for the Louisiana Electors in the "Unpledged" column actually ran on a States' Rights party ticket.
